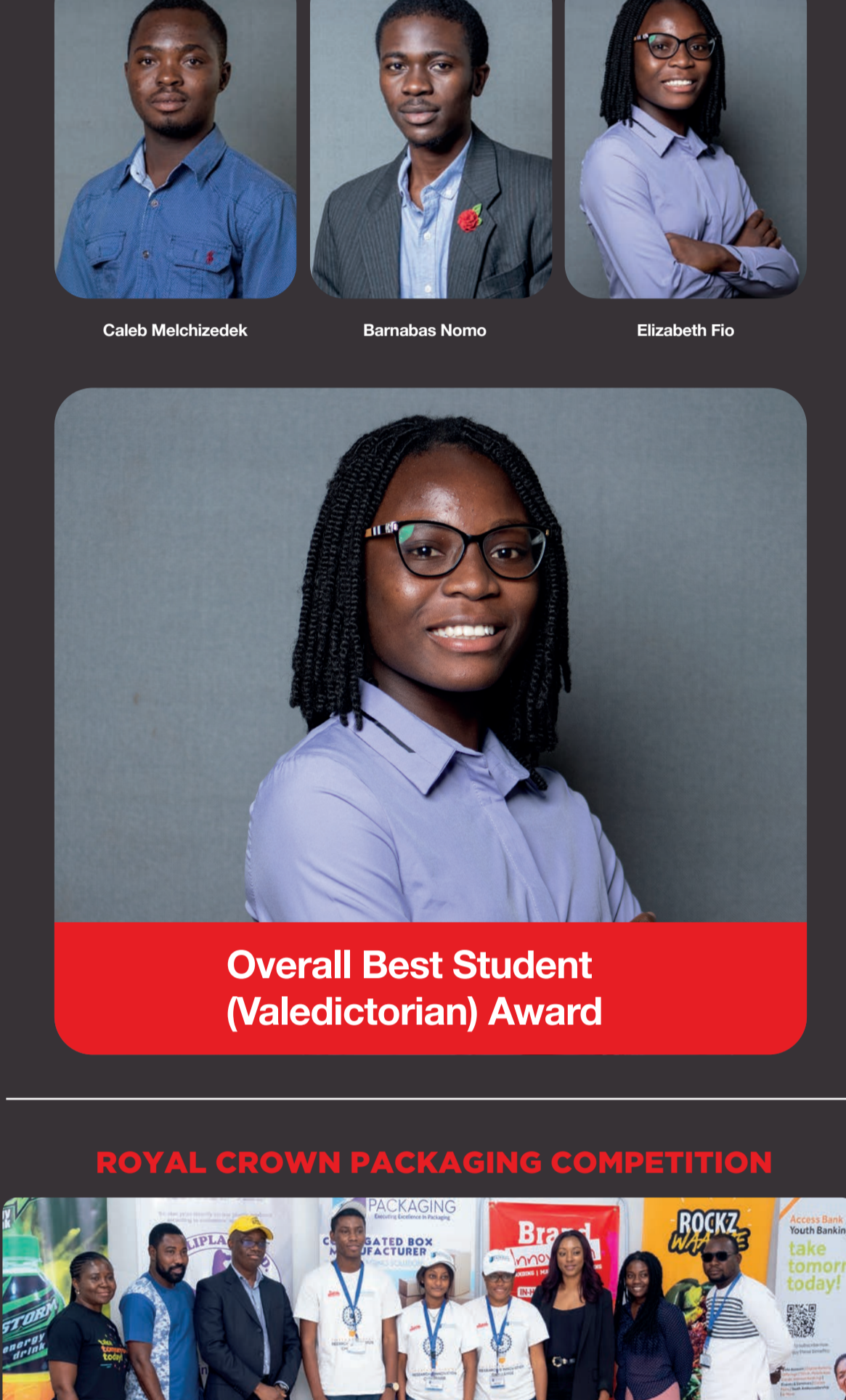


GRADUATION CEREMONY OF CLASS OF 2022

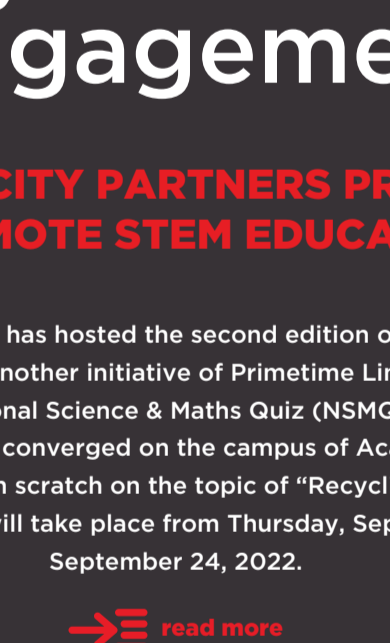

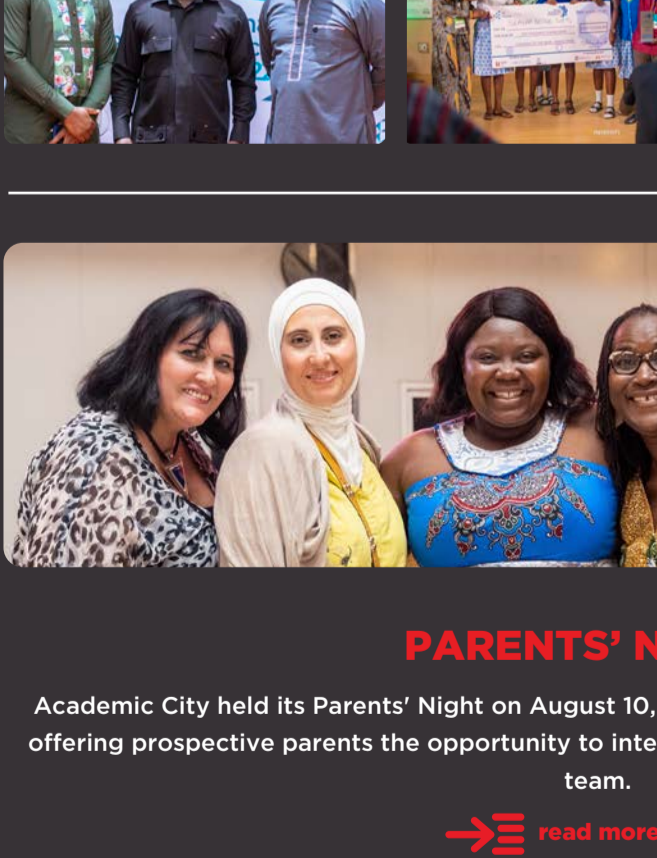
ROYAL CROWN PACKAGING COMPETITION
