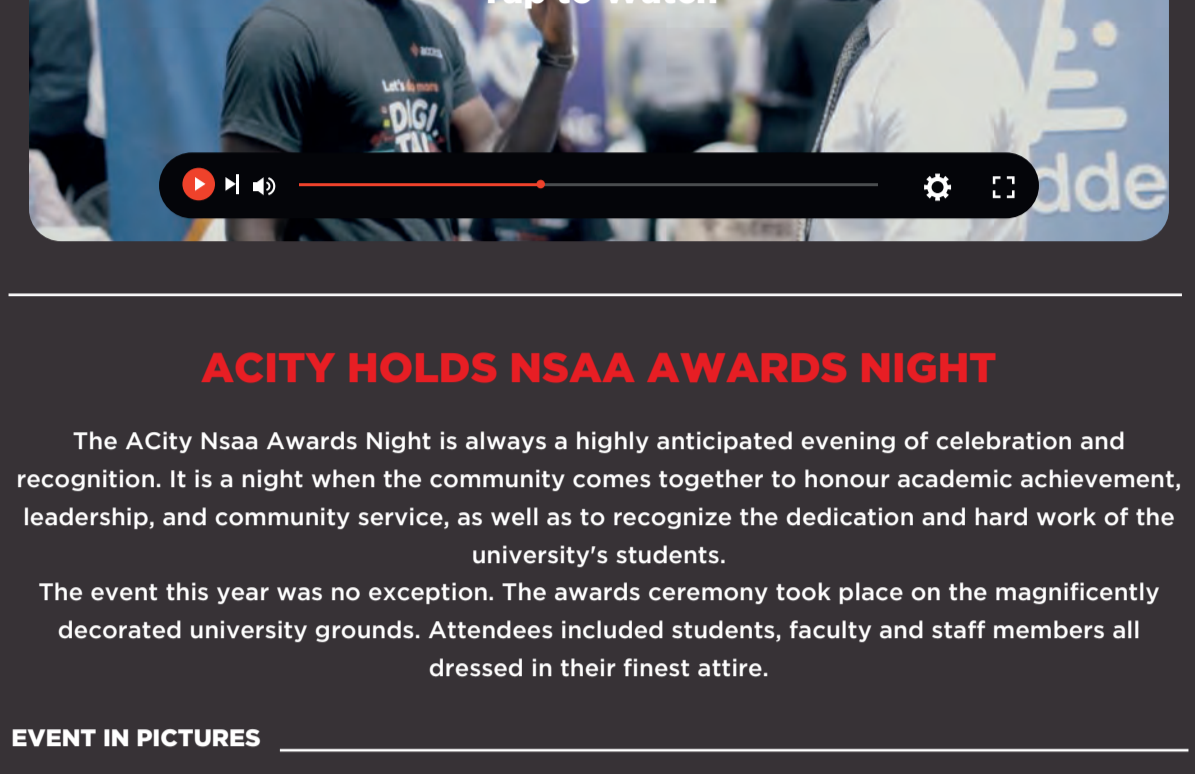

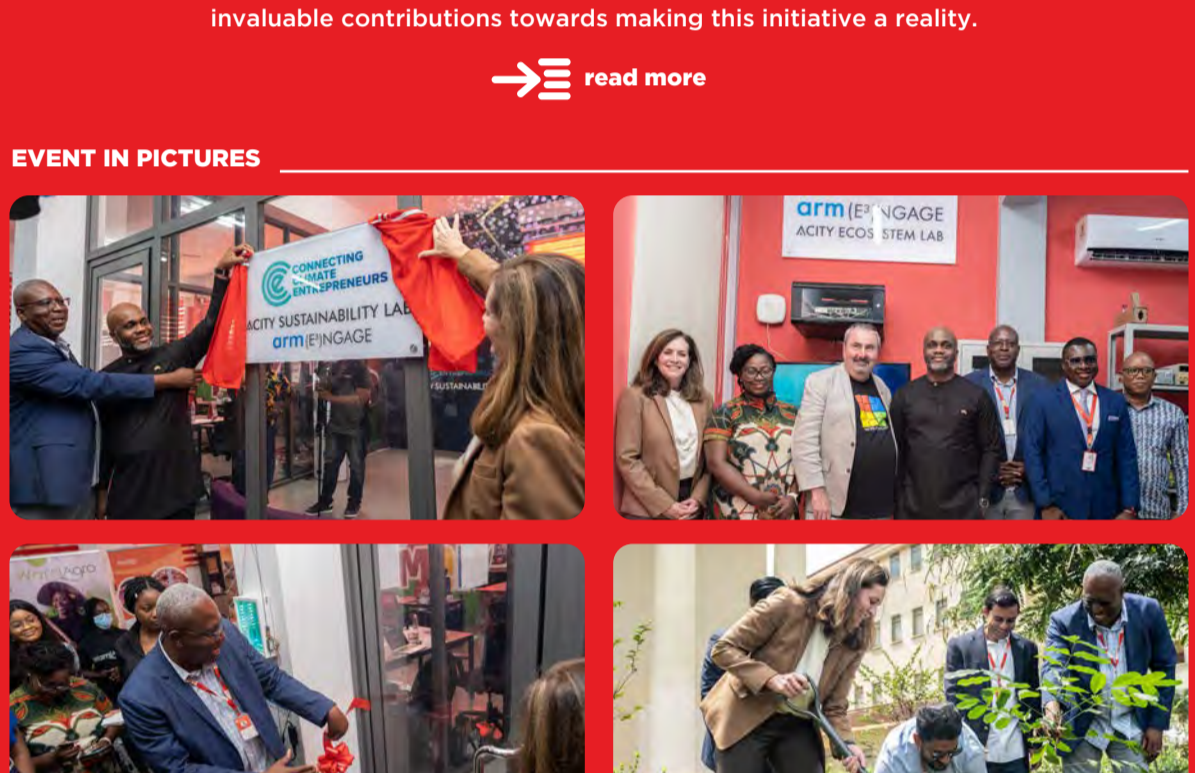
ACITY STUDENTS CONNECT WITH EMPLOYERS

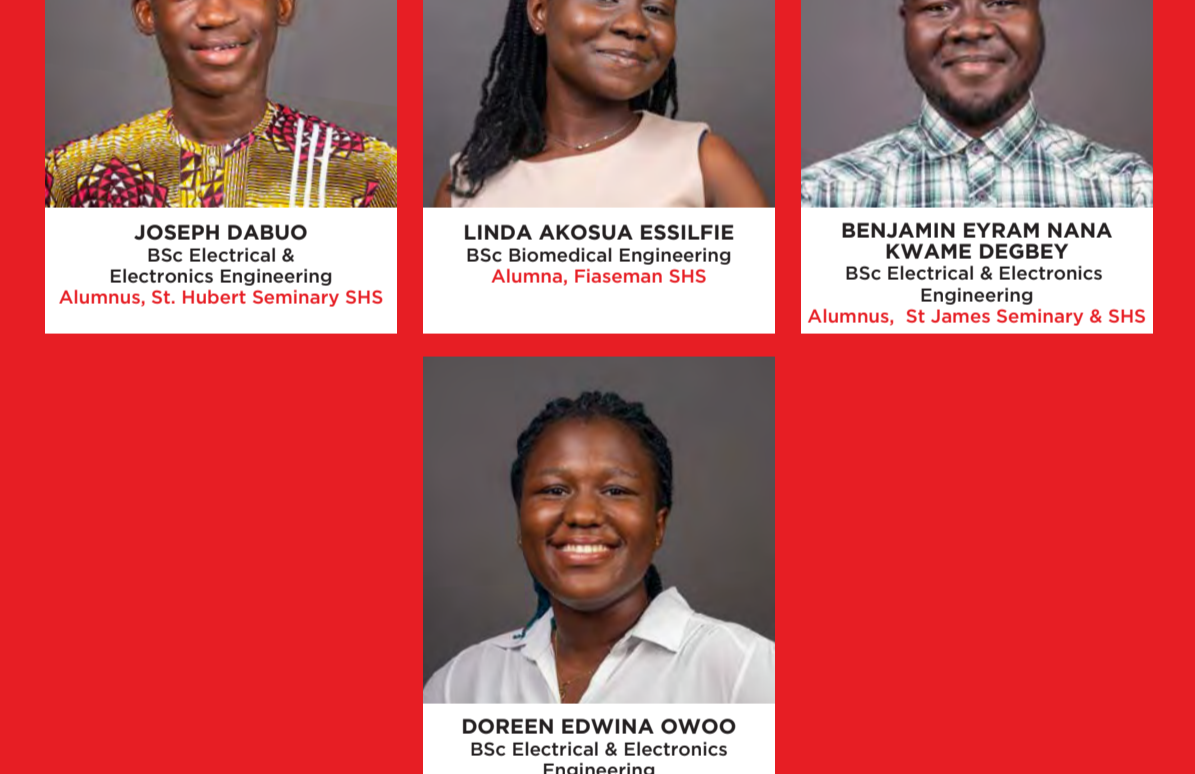


ACITY HOLDS NSAA AWARDS NIGHT

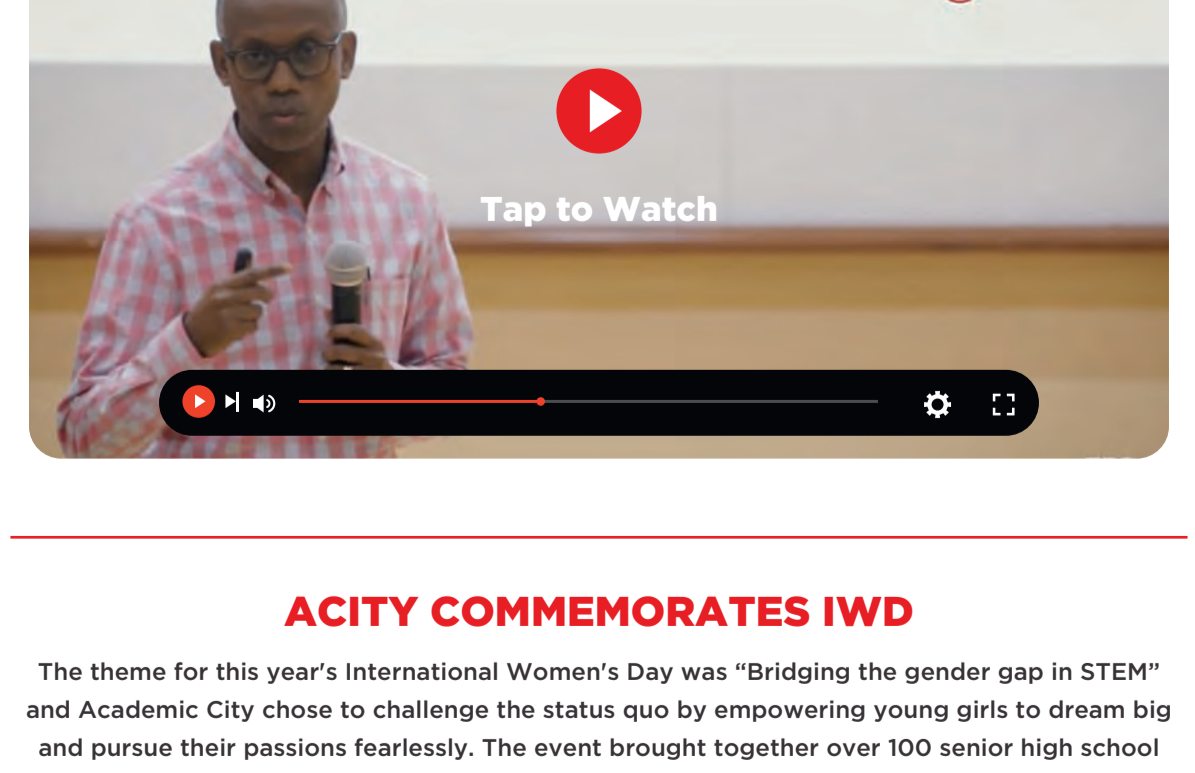
LAUNCH OF ARM AND CCE LAB
