# ACity Celebrates


ACITY@5: CELEBRATING FIVE YEARS OF EXCELLENCE AND INNOVATION




## **GRADUATION CEREMONY CLASS OF 2023**






### **TWO STUDENTS FROM 22' EARN TOP US UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS**
